**Academy Of Hair Design (The)** (OPE ID: 04144400) received education stabilization funds under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"), Public Law No: 116-136. This Fund Report applies to the student portion received under the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund that is designated exclusively for emergency financial aid grants to students.

The institution has received these funds and is distributing them in accordance with the CARES Act and implementing guidance.

1. The institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. The institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$45,188.
3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of this Fund Report is \$45,167.

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## CARES ACT Student Policy

After much thought and consideration, the Academy of Hair Design will take the total student allocation and divide by the number of students in school and allocate the emergency funds this way. This will prevent any discrimination and misunderstandings between students. This is for all currently enrolled students and those on an approved Leave of Absence. The funds may be disbursed to all students, not just Title IV eligible students. This would include any cash pay students that have met the requirements of citizenship, social security number, high school diploma / GED and would be eligible to complete a FAFSA. All funds will be disbursed in one payment.

These funds are for financial disruptions due to COVID 19 and may be used for food; housing; course material, technology, health care and child care.

We recommend that you continue to observe the following preventive measures:

- If you are sick, stay home.
- Avoid close contact with those who are already sick
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing with a tissue or in the crook of your arm.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, or mouth.
